Without you, the success would not have been recorded. Therefore, you should ensure that your paper is corrected and published in our journals. We have three journals, with areas as well. So, even if you sent 5 papers there are journals/ volumes for them.

- 2. The Society has decided that all the papers presented at the conference should be sent for another peer review before they are published. The cost of peer review is N3,000 per article and the Society has decided to pay that cost for only members of the Society. This is part of the benefits of being a member of the Society.
- 3. Any paper that was sent but could not be presented will also be sent for peer review.
- 4. Those who registered when the conference was already concluded will have their paper sent for peer review. If they are registered members of the Society, the Society will pay for the peer review of their paper. Those who still want to send their research documents as Conference Papers are free to do so and will be given certificate of participation, provided they pay the conference fee.
- 5. We encourage all those who presented papers to effect the corrections, however much the corrections may be. We want to assure you that the paper will go through peer review with only "minor corrections" or "no corrections required," provided the GUIDE below is followed. Do not give up. Spend time and effect corrections. That is how to be an academic. Do not get demoralized.
- 6. Paper presenters are requested to follow the correction guide very carefully so that when the paper is sent for peer review it is not returned with "major corrections".
- 7. Note that publication payment will be required for every accepted paper. The Society can only pay for the peer review of the papers of registered members and not publication fees.
- Every paper has to be re-submitted online before 18th February 2019 for peer review. After 20th February 2019 Peer Review fee (N3,000) will be paid by the Paper Presenter.

CORRECTION GUIDE

- 1. Within the Introduction, state clearly the PROBLEM the paper is solving.
- 2. Within the Introduction, state clearly the OBJECTIVE of the research.
- 3. Within the Introduction, state clearly the METHODOLOGY.
- 4. Carefully follow your methodology or argue out your points to finding/conclusion, addressing the Problem of the research.
- 5. Citations must be made profusely to validate claims.

If these four features are not clearly stated the paper will be returned with indication of "major correction."
