Dear Participant,

1. Thank you so much for being part of the Conference. Without you, the success would not have been recorded. We wish to remind you that our Conference contract with you ends after we have published your paper in our “2025 Conference Proceedings.” We can only do this after you have effected corrections, following the GUIDE that we have provided below. We expect you to return corrected papers to us between 17th and 20th November, 2025. After 20th November, 2025 we may not accept corrected papers again and your “Conference Contract” with us would have expired.
2. By some magnanimity, the Society can send your paper for full peer review. Accepted papers shall be published in any of our three International Journals, online. Publication in a Journal is the dream of every academic. So, you should be happy with this development.
 - a. *International Journal of Research in Arts and Social Sciences, IJRASS* (Society Journal, University of Nigeria)
 - b. *International Journal of Theology and Reformed Tradition, IJTRT* (Society Journal, University of Nigeria)
 - c. *Professor Bassej Andah Journal of Humanities and Social Sciences, BAJ* (University of Calabar)
3. Note that, for every paper we send out for review, we pay the reviewers. The Society will not, therefore want to pay for a substandard paper. This is why you have to take our correction guide very seriously.
4. In order to ensure that your paper goes through peer review successfully;
 - a. Within the Introduction, analyze the topic briefly, and then state clearly the **PROBLEM** that the research resolved. It is usually better to formulate this research problem as a question or two, after you have established the premise for the research problem.
 - b. Conclude the Introduction by stating the **METHODOLOGY**. Remember to include the reason for the choice of methodology.
 - c. In the subsequent sections after the Introduction, carefully follow your methodology to argue out your points. By the time your reader gets to the conclusion of the research he would have seen the solution of the Problem of the research as raised in the Introduction.
 - d. From the Introduction to the conclusion, citations must be made very profusely to validate every claim because a research is not a story-telling but solution-oriented report.

If your paper returns from peer review with “major corrections” required, you will have to pay for the second peer review after you have effected corrections again.

The subject of the mail should read **CONFERENCE PAPER FOR REVIEW**. Those who could not present their paper today but duly registered for the Conference should also send their full paper as “CONFERENCE PAPER FOR REVIEW.”

Note that twenty thousand naira (N20,000) late conference registration starts today, for those who could not register but still want to participate in the concluded 2025 conference. They can pay and submit their paper for Conference paper review.
