

Author Guidelines

1. The title should address a societal problem.
2. Abstract; between 30-60 words; a. explain concept, b. state research problem/objective, c. state methodology, d. state finding/conclusion. Keywords should be included after Abstract.
3. The first part of the paper should be Introduction: a. explain concept, b. state research problem/objective, c. state methodology.
4. Length of paper should not exceed 15 pages. Articles should be typed in A4 paper, Times New Roman font, point 11 or 12, double or one and half spacing.
5. Citation should be Turabian (with endnotes – *no footnotes*) or APA (with references, use latest edition of APA – www.apastyle.org), citation must include current sources, at least, two years from the present year. Download citation guide on the website
6. Author's names, department/discipline, institution as well as PHONE NUMBERS must be clearly stated.
7. Diagrams and figures should be well grouped.
8. Submission of paper should be online; attached document in MSWord (not in pdf). Note that we accept articles monthly.

SUMMARY GUIDE TO CONFERENCE PAPER PREPARATION/ARTICLE FOR JOURNAL PUBLICATION

- a. Within the Introduction, state clearly the PROBLEM the paper is solving (but do not create a subtitle on this).
- b. Within the Introduction, state clearly the OBJECTIVE of the research (but do not create a subtitle on this).
- c. Within the Introduction, state clearly the METHODOLOGY (but do not create a subtitle on this).
- d. In the subheadings, after Introduction, the contributor should carefully follow the methodology to logically argue out points to findings/conclusion.
- e. If there are Recommendations they should be placed before the Conclusion.
- f. Citations must be made profusely to validate claims.
- g. Empirical/statistical research should follow a clearly spelt out Methodology.
- h. If you use APA Method then you are not supposed to have Endnotes but References in the APA order.
- i. If you use Turabian Style then use Endnotes
- j. PLEASE DO NOT USE AUTOFORMAT FOR THE ENDNOTES, DO NOT USE FOOTNOTES
